5 Great Questions TO ASK YOUR MENTOR

There are so many questions you can ask your mentor. You can ask about their background and their career, the industry they are in (and you are going into), or what they think about what you are focusing on and aiming for right now.

- 5. Do you think I am setting the right priorities?

Take notes and listen closely to what your mentor shares with you (you are gaining valuable knowledge and information that you likely won't get in school), and don't stop with these questions! Ask more that relate to your situation or the industry specifically.
